This preset pack is a growing collection of Lightroom presets that I use on my macro shots, and now you can too! I add a new preset *weekly* so stay tuned!

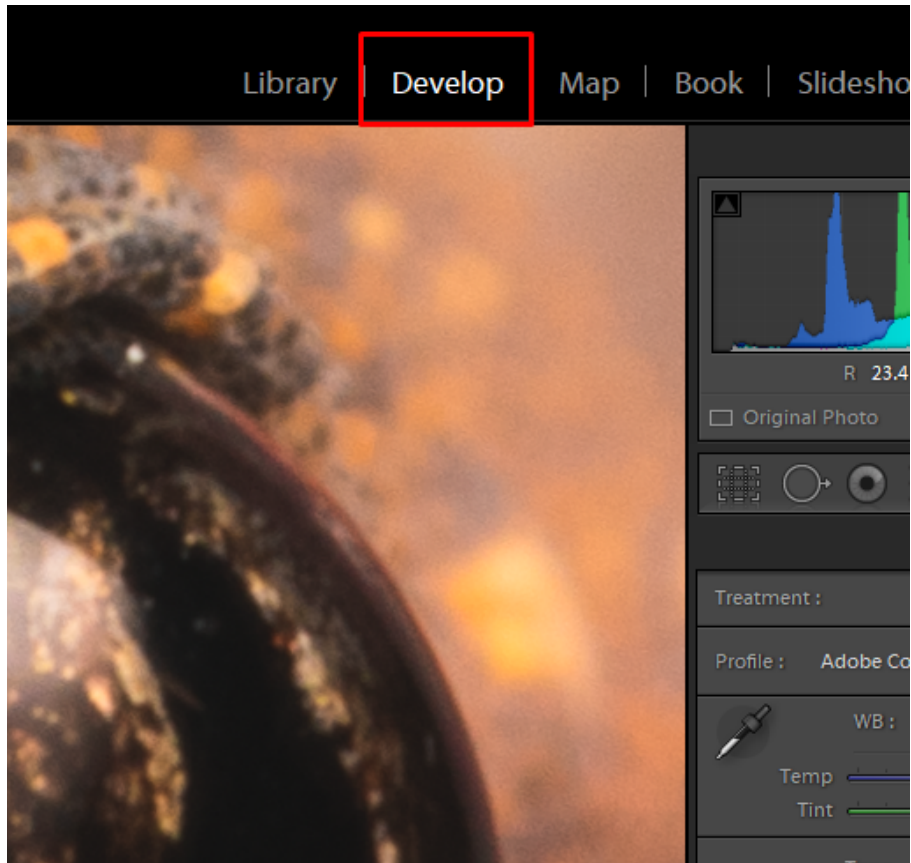

For best results, it is highly recommended that you take a properly-exposed shot or make an exposure adjustment in Lightroom before applying these presets.

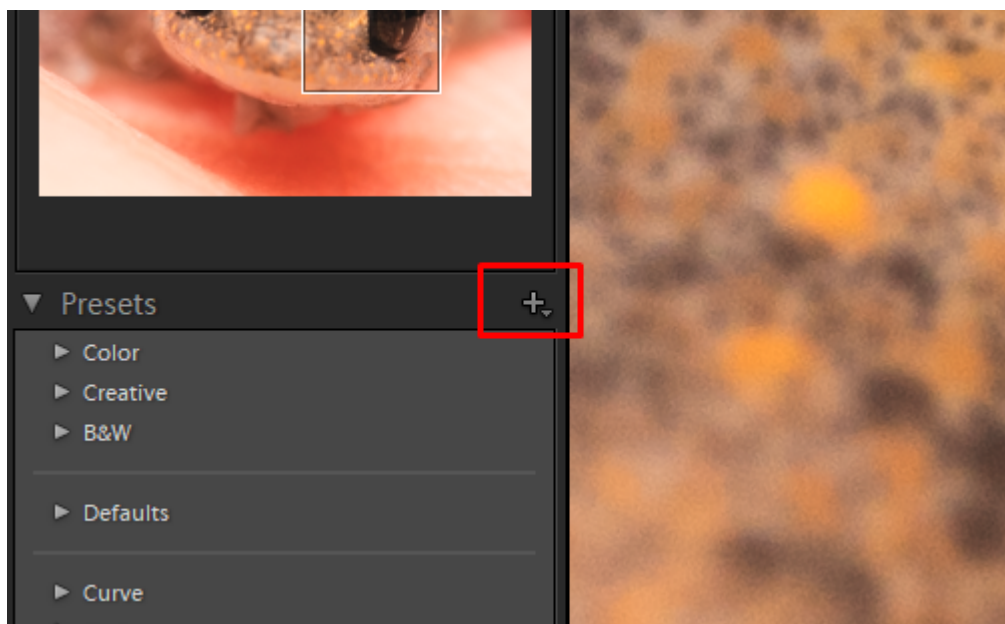

HOW TO INSTALL/USE THE MACRO PRESET PACK

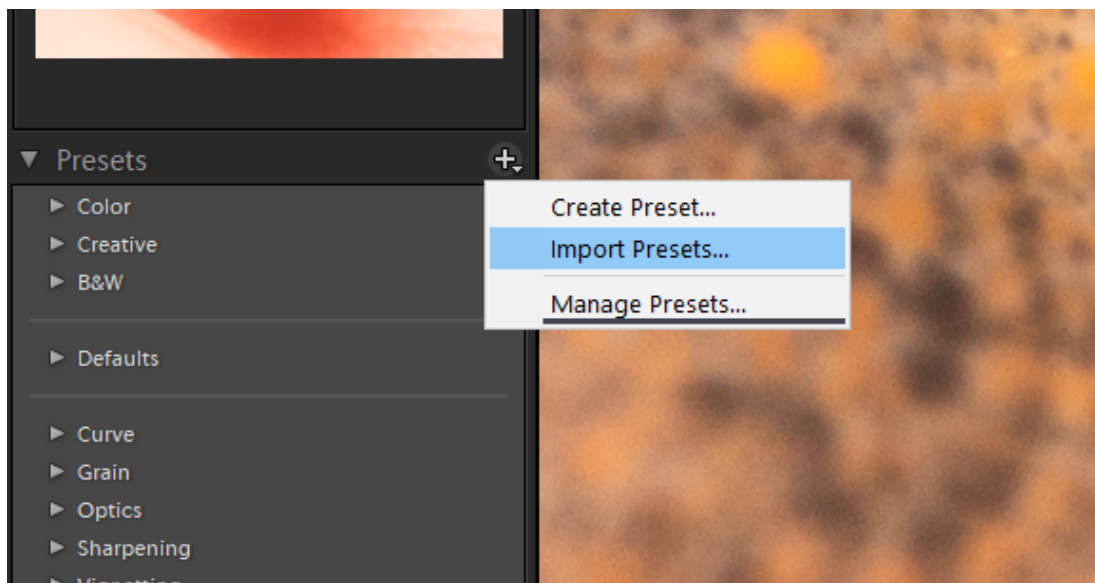
1. With your photo loaded in Lightroom, go to the **Develop** module.



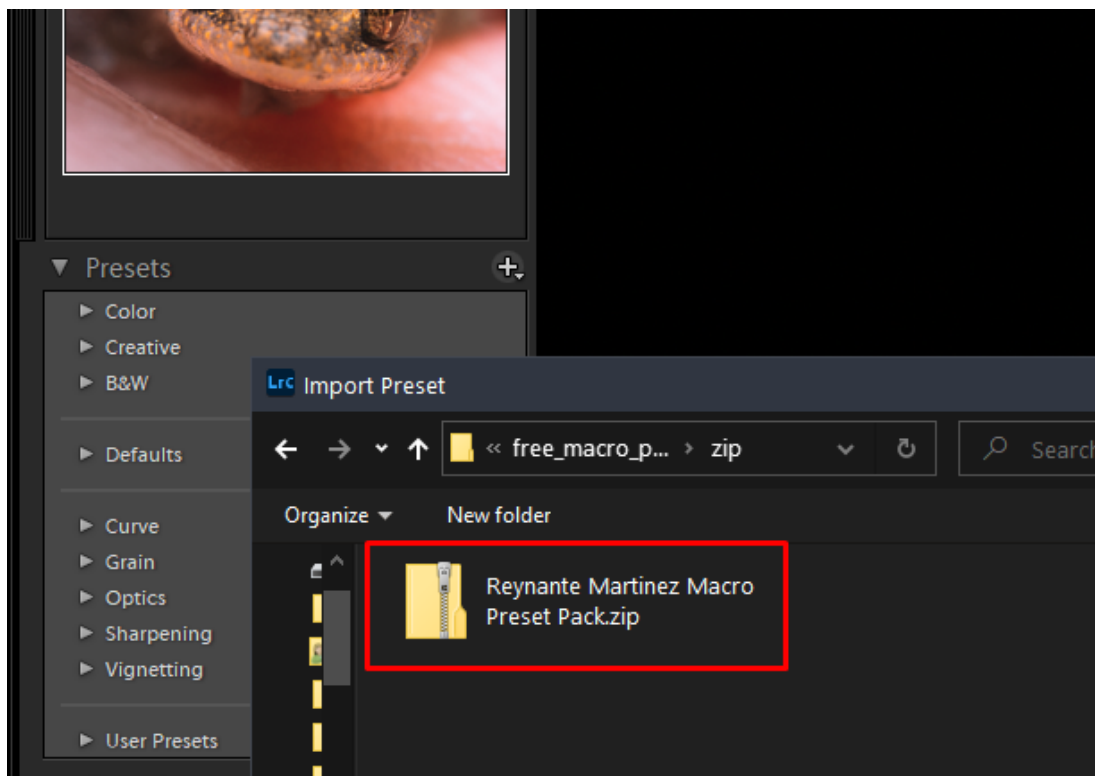
2. On the left-hand side, under **Presets**, click the  icon.



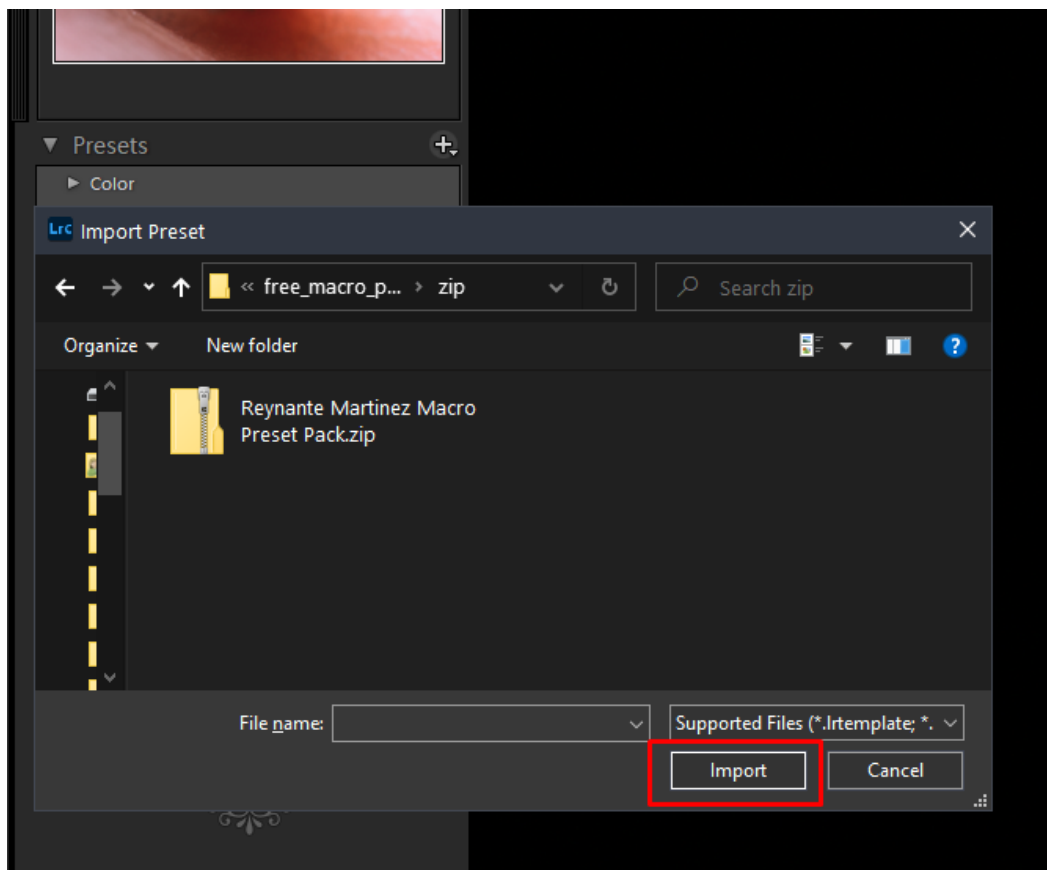

3. Select the **Import Presets** option from the drop-down menu.



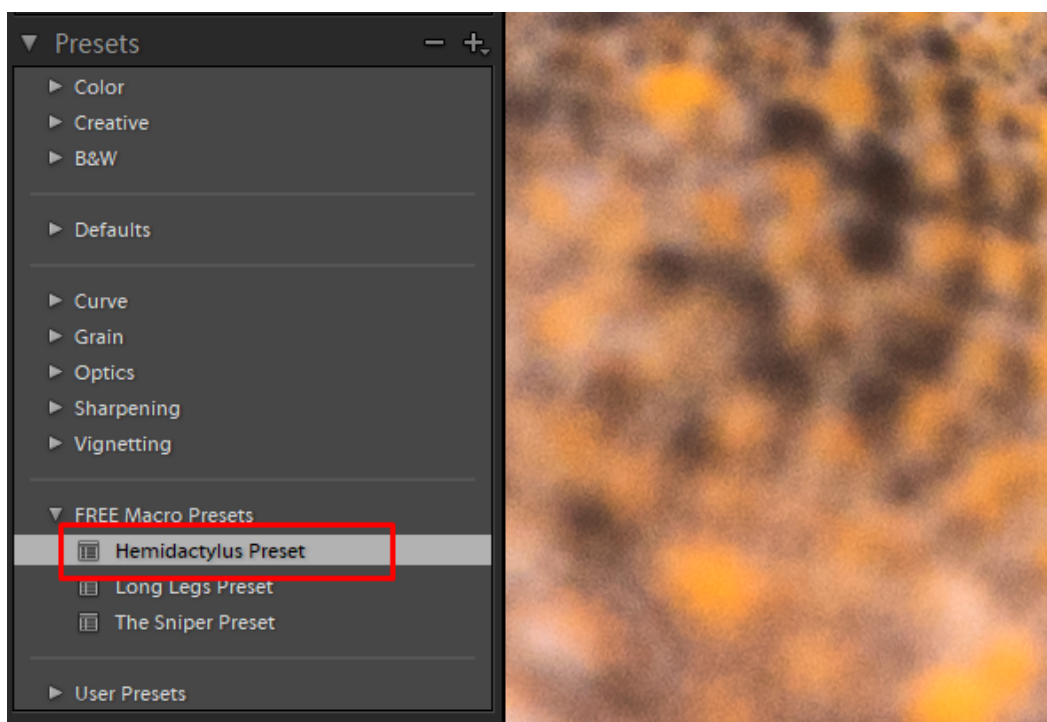
4. Browse to where you've downloaded the preset pack and select the ZIP file.



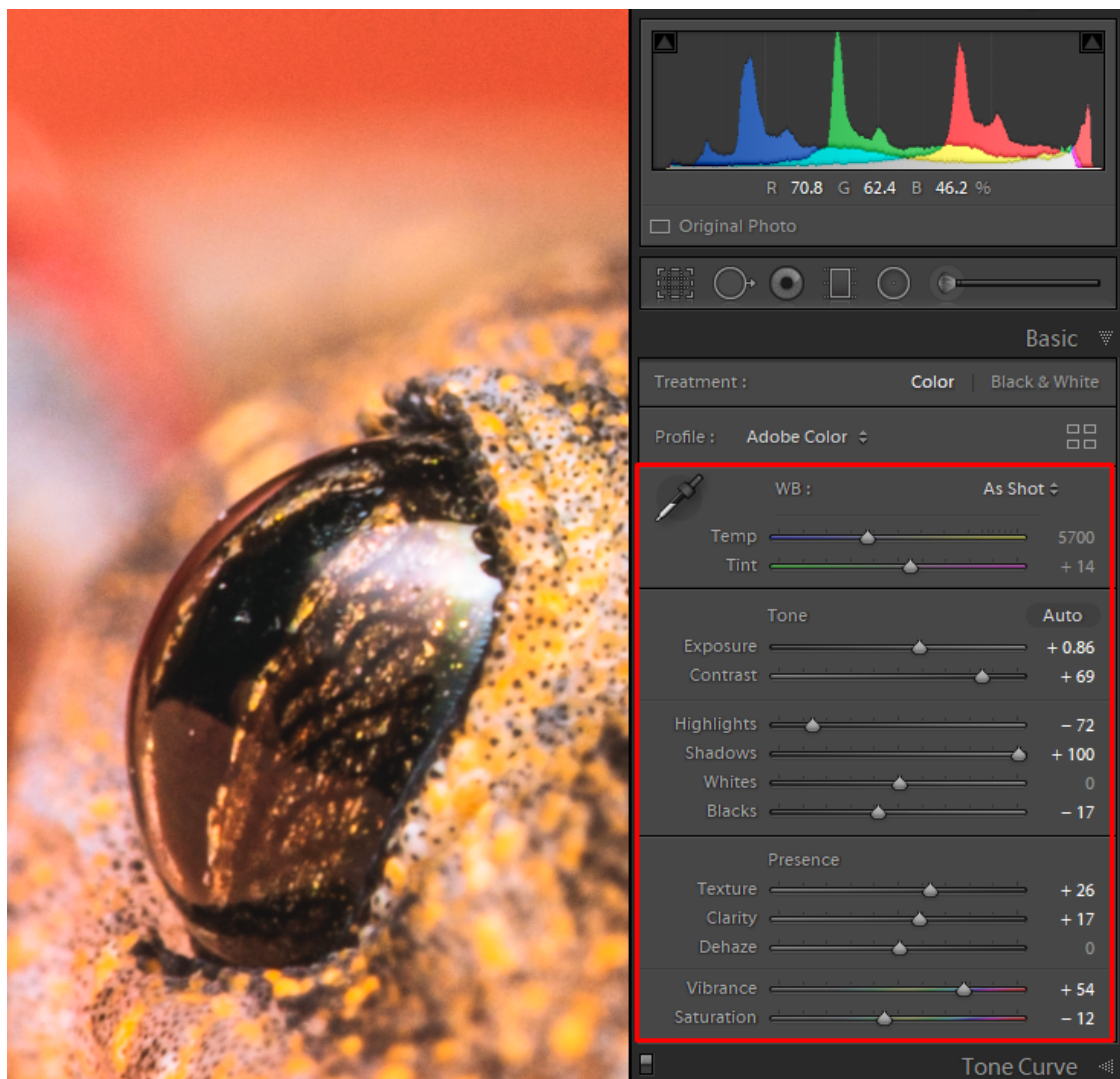
- Click the Import button on the bottom of the dialog window.



- From the Presets panel, select the preset name to activate and apply it to your photo.
